BARN RULES

INITIAL

Owners are expected to keep their horse in good general health: worming regularly, teeth checked annually, yearly tetanus/sleeping sickness vaccination, plus regular shoeing/trimming approximately every 6-8 weeks. In case of emergency, Holman Ranch Stables reserves the right to contact a veterinarian or farrier at the owner's expense. All boarders are responsible for cleaning up after their horse outside pasture/corral/stalls (including manure, clippings, mane/tail brushes, hoof cleaning, etc.). Please also keep the area litter free (cans, bottles, tissues, etc.).

Boarders must have a signed and completed release on file with the Stables Office prior to riding. Guests or trainers of boarders may not ride unless the following are on file in the Stables Office:

- Completed and signed release
- Owner's permission to ride horse.

Holman Ranch reserves the right to refuse riding by guests/trainers.

Boarders and their registered guests may ride in the arenas and on designated ranch trails seven days a week. Please no riding before sunrise or after sunset without permission from the Ranch Manager. Jumping is not permitted without the supervision of a trainer. Approved helmets must be worn when jumping; persons 18 years or younger must wear helmets at all times when riding. Occasionally, events, lessons, filming, or photo shoots may be held in the Stables area or arenas. Boarder services will continue as usual; however, use of these areas may be temporarily restricted. Check with the calendar on the Barn Bulletin Board to find out the scheduled activities. Boarders may not use any Holman Ranch tack, equipment, supplies, food, medicine, etc. without permission from the Ranch Manager.

A halter and lead, or bridle must be on horse when outside corral/stall/paddock. For safety, do not tie horses to anything that can be pulled out, away or broken (e.g. paddock pipes, etc.) Do not ride double or with just a halter and rope.

Please notify Ranch Manager immediately if you notice any injured horses, broken fences, damaged equipment, etc. The Ranch Manager must be notified when a horse is to be away overnight (we don't want to worry).

Arenas, trails, roads, mounting benches, jumps, equipment, etc. that you use at Holman Ranch are used at your own risk. Holman Ranch is not responsible for your use or the use by your guest or vendors of any of the above or other items. Please leave doors/gates that you use as you find them. If you should ride on trails in the area please be especially quiet when near homes and be courteous to our neighbors. Please see management for trail information.

Do not feed any horse but your own without owner's permission. Do not allow your horse to "sniff noses" with other horses, as this can lead to injuries.

Absolutely no smoking in barn area, pastures, trails, or arenas because of extreme fire danger.

Dogs are allowed if leashed. Dogs may not be left unattended while riding.

Any jumping must be while under the supervision of a Holman Ranch authorized instructor.

Drive slowly. Please respect the 15 miles per hour signs posted while driving on ranch property.
